

CEDARVILLE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY MATERIALS RETURN GUIDE

When are my library items due?

The library has been automatically extending due dates for library items (including OhioLINK items) and will do so until May 8. At that point, due dates will no longer be extended automatically. Library items may be returned to the library at any point.

What library items do I have checked out?

You may check your library account at library.cedarville.edu/patroninfo.

How do I return library items?

Library materials (including OhioLINK and interlibrary loan items) can be returned in our drop box located in the library lobby. This drop box is accessible at any time. Library items can also be mailed to the library.

What if I don't return my library items?

Items will be automatically renewed until May 8. At that point, you will be responsible to renew items you wish to continue using through our website. Any item not returned by its due date will be considered overdue. You will be billed a replacement cost for any item not returned by 30 days past its due date.

What about public library items I have checked out?

If you have checked out materials from Greene County Public Library, you may return those items using our book drop at Centennial Library. We will ensure that the items are returned to the Greene County Public Library and no fines will be assessed for returned Greene County items. The Greene County Public Library is currently closed during the Ohio Stay at Home Order.
